

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS**

This Agreement is not and shall not be construed as a contract of Employment.

Nothing in this agreement will amount to any guarantee of a place at any Camp.

### **1. Fees & Application**

1.1 To apply to the programme, the fees set out in Schedule 1 are payable.

1.2 Upon receipt of the fees, the Participant will benefit from the following:

- Advice and guidance throughout the year
- Mandatory Orientation days prior to departure to the USA.
- Assistance in travel
- Emergency 24/7 support whilst at Camp
- Travel and medical insurance for camp
- Return flights

1.3 The following third-party fees will also be payable by the Participant:

- Travel to and from mandatory events
- Any visa documents if required
- Fees for medical forms if required by Camp

1.4 The Participant will provide JCUSA with 3 independent, professional references. The consent of all referees must be obtained when submitting their details.

1.5 The completed application, interview, references, will determine eligibility for a place at Camp.

1.6 The Participant will inform JCUSA of any changes in their circumstances, from the date of application for a place on the Programme, to the end date with Camp. Any false, misleading or withheld information will be grounds for immediate termination from the programme without refund.

1.7 JCUSA will interview the prospective Participant to assess their skills and experience.

1.8 If successful, following interview JCUSA will contact the Participant.

## **2. Data Protection**

2.1 Information collected during the application process will be limited to that which enables JCUSA to carry out the interview successfully.

2.2 Information collected as part of the application will be shared with Camps which JCUSA determines would be suitable. Camp will not be entitled to share such information with anyone other than members of their team and in accordance with our GDPR policy which is available on request.

2.3 JCUSA will only share personal information with relevant third parties where legal requirements can be met.

## **3. Visa Process**

3.1 If the Participant has a US passport or US Green Card, they will be obliged to travel on these documents.

3.2 No refund will be paid if a visa is refused.

## **4. Your Summer Camp**

4.1 If the Participant is successful at the JCUSA interview they will be offered a place at a Camp.

4.2 A Camp director will interview the Participant. This will be online

4.3 The selection process for Camps is open until May.

4.4 Once a place is offered, the final decision is between the Participant and the Camp.

## **5. Travel to the USA**

5.1 JCUSA reserves the right to inform Camp and withdraw the Participant from the programme if the participant has not paid in full for travel one month prior departure.

5.2 JCUSA will provide instructions regarding travel to and from Camp at least month before travelling. You will be collected by camp on arrival.

5.3 JCUSA is not responsible or liable for any changes, cancellations and/or costs incurred for any international, in-transit, domestic, travelling and/or transfers at any time.

## **6. Medical and Travel Insurance**

6.1 If the Participant has a US passport or US Green Card, they will be obliged to arrange their own medical insurance.

6.2 JCUSA provides fully comprehensive medical insurance beginning 48 hours prior to the departure for Camp covering the duration of the camp. This insurance does not cover any Pre-existing medical conditions during the 36-month period prior to departure for the USA.

6.3 Any pre-existing medical conditions or regular medication must be declared on your JCUSA application form.

6.4 Any excess/deductible, will be payable by the Participant on any qualifying claims.

6.5 If the Participant leaves camp or gets asked to leave camp early, the insurance policy will end the following day.

## **7. Summer**

7.1 Successful Participants will be sent documents to complete for the camp. In which the dates of the programme will be stated.

7.2 JCUSA is not responsible for recovering any unpaid payments.

7.3 JCUSA cannot not accept liability for any decisions or actions made by the Camp.

7.4 In the event that a Camp cancels prior to the start date, no refund or compensation will be payable.

7.5 If Camp decides to ask you to leave prior to the end date, the Participant's shall cease to be on the JCUSA programme. JCUSA will not be responsible for any costs incurred as a result.

7.6 If the Participant leaves Camp or is asked to leave early, JCUSA will not be responsible for any travel arrangements. Participants will provide JCUSA with an updated flight itinerary.

## **8. Refund and Cancellation Policy**

8.1 No refund will be payable in the event that the Participant is unsuccessful following any JCUSA or Camp interview, or if they decide to withdraw from the programme for any reason.

8.2 No refunds will be payable by JCUSA under any circumstances including but not limited to: any events beyond JCUSA's control, the Participant withdrawing from the programme for any reason, Camp being cancelled, natural disasters, acts of war or terrorism, strikes, incidents of politically motivated violence, sickness or quarantine, pandemics, government restrictions or regulations or transportation accidents.

## **9. General**

9.1 If the Participant fails to complete any part of the JCUSA preparation or is in the opinion of JCUSA unlikely to participate fully in the programme, they may be withdrawn from the programme.

9.2 Participants are required to attend orientation events prior to the commencement of their camp programme. All costs incurred shall be paid by the Participant.

9.3 Participation in the JCUSA programme begins from the initial application to the end of the Camp

9.4 In the event of any dissatisfaction, all complaints should be sent to JCUSA via email by October 30th in the year the Participant applied for or participated in the programme.

9.5 If the Participant wishes to return to Camp for another year, they are required to do so within the JCUSA programme.

- 9.6 If any court or competent authority finds that any provision of this agreement (or part of any provision) is invalid, illegal or unenforceable, that provision or part-provision shall, to the extent required, be deemed to be deleted, and the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this agreement shall not be affected.
- 9.7 This agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of England and Wales, and each party irrevocably agrees to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
- 9.8 The Participant shall abide by all applicable laws and fully defend, indemnify JCUSA and its officers, directors, employees, agents, successors and permitted assigns from and against any claims, liability, obligation, loss and expenses including court costs and legal fees incurred by the Participant or a third party arising out of or resulting from bodily injury, death of any person or damage to real or tangible, personal property resulting from the wilful, fraudulent or negligent acts or omissions of the Participant.
- 9.9 JCUSA and its' affiliates, agents and employees shall not be liable for refunds, claims or costs whatsoever arising from any injury, loss, damage, delay, accident or expense resulting from events beyond JCUSA's control including (but not limited to) natural disasters, acts of war or terrorism, strikes, incidents of politically motivated violence, sickness or quarantine, pandemics, government restrictions or regulations or transportation accidents.
